826-2872/2873/2955 F3000 Kit Installation Instructions

Follow these instructions to replace a FAST VC 210 controller with an F3000:

- Prior to removing existing controller, compare the existing menu strip's products against the new menu strip's products. Note any additional products that do not exist on the new controller. Go into programming and note cook times and temperatures.
- 2. Remove power from the unit.
- 3. Remove the two screws attaching the existing controller to the frame. See Figure 1.
- Lower the controller and disconnect the two wire harnesses attached to the controller. See Figure 2.
- Remove menu strip from new controller and add any new products not listed using a permanent marker. See Figure 3
- 6. Reinsert menu strip fully into controller slot.
- Align the new controller bezel to the fryer to check for proper fit. If necessary, remove the tinnerman clips for proper fit. See Figure 4. If this controller has a radio installed, ensure it is installed on the far right fryer on multi-battery fryers. See Figure 5.
- Attach supplied harness to new controller and attach 2-pin and 9-pin existing fryer harnesses to supplied harness. See Figure 6.
- 9. Attach controller to control panel frame using supplied screws.
- 10. Return power and test operation.
- It may be necessary to program additional products into the controller using the times and temperatures noted in step # 1. Follow the setup instructions on the following pages to ensure the fryer type, time etc. is correct.

The F3000 <u>must be configured</u> for the specific fryer. Failure to configure it properly, prior to use, may result in fryer malfunction.

Install the F3000 by removing the existing computer and replacing with the new computer. Ensure that the computer control cable is securely fastened to the computer and that the ground is secured.

- 1. With the computer displaying OFF, press and hold the ✓ (check) key until Product Setup is displayed.
- 2. Press the ► (right) arrow key two times until **TECH MODE** is displayed. Press the ✓ (check) key.
- 3. Enter code 7628.
- 4. Follow the sequence below to configure the computer.

Additional configuration parameters

To set up additional parameters such as time, date, language, etc. enter setup using the directions below.

- 1. With the computer displaying OFF, press and hold the ✓ (check) key until Product Setup is displayed.
- 2. Press the \blacktriangleright (right) arrow key until **VAT SETUP** is displayed. Press the \checkmark (check) key.
- 3. Enter code 3228.
- 4. Follow the sequence below to configure the computer.

2 POLISH DELRY TIME	1:00	Use numbered keys to change time. (This is the amount of time which an operator can delay the start of the second polish. The default is 1:00.) Press ►.
2 Polish Strrt Tenpr	300F	Use numbered keys to change temperature. (This is the required temperature for the second polish to begin. The default is 300F.) Press ▶.
EXIT	EXIT	Press SCAN button three times to return the computer to OFF.
