

Time-Delay Board Replacement



Follow these instructions when replacing a time-delay relay (807-4934 or 807-4812) in a LOV gas fryer:

- 1. Access the board in the right side of the control box in a full vat and on either side in a dual vat.
- 2. Mark wires to ensure they are returned to the proper stud.
- 3. Remove board and replace with new board, replacing wires.
- 4. Ensure the ground wire, either attached to a stud in the control box (above and left) or attached to a board mounting stud, is securely sandwiched between two nuts.





The time-delay relay board is shown in place above. The left photo shows the current placement of the mounting stud. The right photo shows the original grounding to a board mounting stud. Replacement of the board in either style grounding requires the ground wire terminal to be sandwiched between two nuts on the stud.
