## SDU Pump Head Replacement

DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN

the NPT threads on the pump head close nipple.

NOTE: The reassembled pump will require priming:

- 1. Turn the pump and suction tube upside down.
- 2. Pour one cup of cooking oil into the suction tube.
- 3. Rotate the pump handle clockwise three to four times.
- 4. Turn the pump and suction tube right side up and insert fully into the oil reservoir. Ensure it reaches the bottom of the pan.

Tighten pump head only 1 to 2 turns past hand tight.

- 1. Apply Loctite to the threads of the close nipples.
- 2. Note the directional arrow on the check valve. The arrow goes up.
- 3. Insert close nipples and tighten 1 to 2 turns past hand tight.
- 4. Attach pump head and tighten one to two turns past hand tight. **DO NOT** bottom out the pump base against the close nipple flange.
- 5. Attach pump handle with 65 inch-pounds of torque.
- 6. Attach the spout, using Loctite on the close nipples, and tightening 1 to 2 turns past hand tight.
- 7. See instructions (left) on priming pump.
