#### **Overview – Multi-Product Mode (5050)**



Press once for current temperature, twice for setpoint: 360°F(182°C).

Lane Keys twice for Press to initiate cook cycle. PROD appears in left display; press a menu key immediately after pressing the cook key to launch a cook cycle for the chosen product. Lane keys are also used to move through programming steps. Press second key to advance, first (yellow) key to go back. NOTE: The "B" (blue) key is disabled when setup for two-lane.

Checkmark Key With computer off, used to enter and confirm programming modes.

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#### **Status Indicator**

Displays OFF when fryer is off, dashed lines when fryer is at setpoint. Displays HI, LO and HOT when the fryer is out of temperature range.

#### Heat LED

LED is illuminated when the fryer is heating.

Button LED's LED's above buttons are illuminated when the product is cooking; flash to indicate holding time.







## **Programming New Menu Items in Multi Product Computer**

Follow these steps to enter a new product in the computer. The actions to be taken are in the right column; the computer displays are shown in the left and middle columns.
