Daily Filter Pan Cleaning and Preparation

The filter <u>pad in a Manual LOV™</u> <u>fryer must be replaced at least</u> <u>once daily</u>. In high-volume stores it should be replaced more often.



Replace O-rings every 90 days.

The filter pan must be cleaned daily and the filter pad replaced. Follow these instructions to prepare the filter pan:


Remove and disassemble



the pan. Discard old filter pad. Clean thoroughly. Leave no water in the pan.

Reassemble the pan in this order:

- 1. Position the inner screen.
- 2. Place the filter pad, textured





side up, in the pan.

- 3. Position the hold-down ring on the filter pad.
- 4. Position the crumb tray.
- 5. Firmly seat the filter pan in the cabinet.
