SUBJECT: Defective High-limit Thermostat

Due to vendor error, a number of high-limit snap disc thermostats have been found to be defective. The ½" NPT male threads are too large and will not properly seal in the ½" NPT couplings. The defective high-limit thermostats will only screw into a ½" NPT coupling approximately ¾ of a turn by hand. A good high-limit will screw into a ½" NPT coupling a minimum of 3 turns by hand.

ASA's that received parts shipped from Frymaster from September 18, 2007 through and including October 1, 2007 need to check their stock of service high-limit thermostats listed below to ensure that all high-limits screw into a ½" NPT coupling a minimum of 3 turns **by hand**. Defective high-limits have been found with date codes of 0738 and 0739. The date code is the four digit number that follows "807-2274" on the end of the thermostat.
