SUBJECT: Gas Leak Testing

During the installation of a gas fryer or any maintenance to the gas system of a fryer, check all connections made during the installation or maintenance for leaks. Check existing connections and any piping disturbed during the installation or maintenance.

Perform the test with a gas detector, a noncorrosive leak-detection fluid, or other leak-detection methods (soap solution). If a leak is detected, tighten and test until there are no leaks on the connections. **DO NOT USE matches, candles, open flames, or any method that provides a source of ignition.**



Gas connections made or adjusted during the installation or repair of a fryer should be tested with a leak detection fluid at the completion of the service work.
